

MAKING AN IMPACT

The Crystal Charity Ball has benefited more than 158 children's charities.

DALLAS CASA (COURT APPOINTED SPECIAL ADVOCATES)

Voices for Children Wing

Crystal Charity funded the construction of a supervisors' wing in CASA's new headquarters located near the Wilson Historic District in East Dallas in 2016. The Crystal Charity gift of \$960,000 allows CASA to serve more than 3,900 abused and neglected children who are placed in foster care because they cannot live safely at home.



CALLIER CENTER FOR COMMUNICATIONS DISORDERS

In 2016, the Crystal Charity Ball awarded the Callier Center a grant for \$630,000 to provide hearing evaluations, hearing aids and three years of follow-up services to approximately 360 children from low-income families. Through Crystal Charity's generosity, 241 children have benefited from treatment to date, and Callier will continue to enroll children in 2019.



NORTH TEXAS FOOD BANK

In 2015, the Crystal Charity Ball funded the Food 4 Kids Backpack Program. Developed as a solution to weekend hunger, Food 4 Kids provides a backpack of nutritious foods to chronically hungry children every Friday throughout the school year.

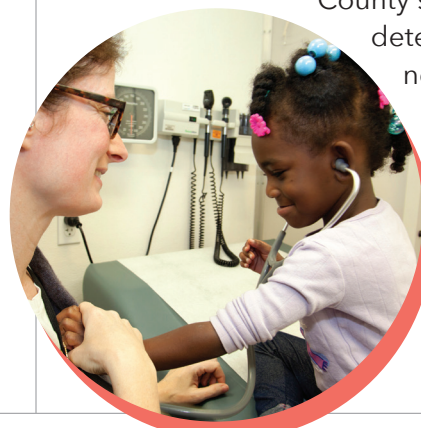
Approximately 1,468 elementary-aged children and their younger siblings will be provided 52,854 backpacks each school year, or the equivalent of 634,248 meals over three years.



PARKLAND FOUNDATION

The Crystal Charity Ball Mobile Medical Clinic

The Crystal Charity Ball funded a new van to replace one that was old and unreliable. Since the program received funding in 2017, the Parkland HOMES team has cared for more than 2,500 homeless children across 28 shelters and Dallas County schools and juvenile detention centers. With the new Crystal Charity Ball mobile medical clinic, they are confident they will get to each location on time and ready to work with homeless kids and their families.

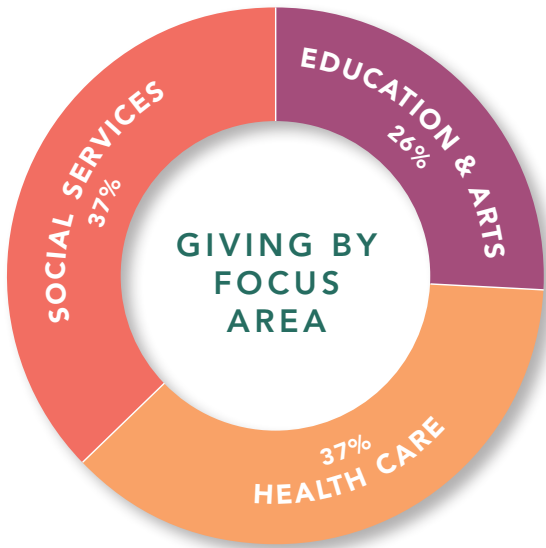


NOTRE DAME SCHOOL OF DALLAS

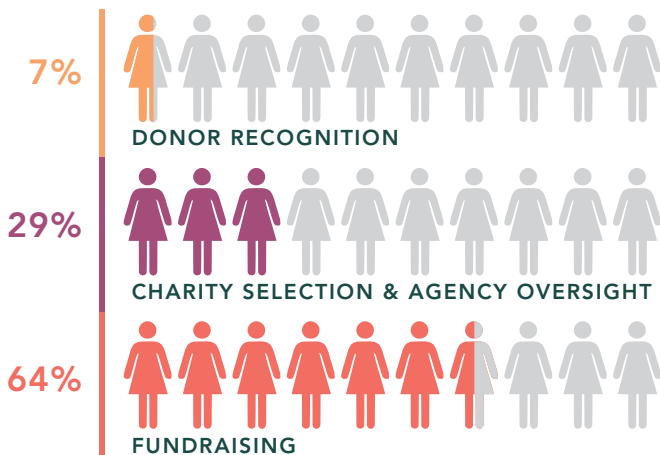


PURPOSE

Throughout our 67-year history, The Crystal Charity Ball has generated more than \$149 million for the children of Dallas. Each year funds raised benefit children of Dallas County through programs and services provided by our Beneficiaries.

ANNUAL VOLUNTEER HOURS

In 2018, the members of Crystal Charity spent more than 18,900 volunteer hours.



2019 BENEFICIARIES

In 2019, Crystal Charity will serve 21,541 children ages 0-18 through ten selected beneficiaries.

Eighty-five percent of the children served live below the poverty line.
